



SPINAL CORD INJURY BY COUNTRY
from traumatic causes
1959–2008

- Annual incidence per million people**
- 30 – 49
 - 10 – 29
 - fewer than 10
 - spinal cord incidence data insufficient for inter-country comparison
 - no data

- Aetiology of injury median percentile**
- land transport
 - falls
 - sports/recreation
 - violence/self-harm
 - work-related
- Percentage of cases resulting in mortality**
- up to 1 year from injury
 - 1 – 10 years
